HELPFUL TIPS FOR NEW (and old) RESIDENTS

HOA FEE: The Countryside HOA fee is \$140 billed annually in July and due by August 1. **HOA MEETINGS**: Quarterly meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday in January, April, July and October. The annual membership meeting is the 2nd Tuesday of September.

TRASH DAY: Mondays- The city provides trash and recycle bins. They should be placed at least 4 feet apart at the curb, facing the street.

WATER: Countryside was annexed into the city in 2016. Trash and water are billed together by the city, and water charges are based on usage. Contact the city for any concerns with water, trash or recycling.

MAILBOXES: You can have your mailbox re-keyed at the USPS.

PARK / COMMON AREAS: Residents are welcome to enjoy the park and walking paths throughout the community. Please be kind and pick up after yourself and your pets.

ANNUAL EVENTS: Community Garage Sale and Annual Clean Up each Spring - watch mailbox, newsletter and website for dates.

WILDLIFE: Fun to watch, but feeding the deer and turkeys is strictly prohibited.

STREET PARKING: Per our covenants: On-street parking is restricted to emergencies, deliveries and guests. No overnight parking on streets is permitted.
