IMPORTANT UPDATES—PLEASE READ

- ⇒ The HOA has voted to repair areas of the walking path and slabs near mailboxes that are lifted or broken up. Please use caution around some of the mailboxes where we have noticed some deterioration. As soon as weather permits, these areas will be repaired.
- ⇒ Reminder: the walking paths are not maintained during winter months. Please use caution if you choose to use them while they are snow covered or icey.
- ⇒ The city is now offering water and sewer/septic service line coverage with Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA). If you have not looked into this, you can get more info at www.slwofa.com.
- ⇒ Before our last meeting, you received a letter regarding our HOA covenants encouraging homeowners to attend the October meetings as we begin discussion to update/revise the covenants. The committee has begun meeting and will present recommended revisions soon. In order to change our covenants, a 66 2/3% affirmative vote is required.
- ⇒ A huge thank-you to our new board members voted in during our October meeting. (See side panel for contact info.) We appreciate everyone willing to volunteer their time to keep Countryside a great place to live.

HELPFUL TIPS FOR NEW RESIDENTS

HOA FEE: The Countryside HOA fee is \$140 billed annually in July and due by August 1.

HOA MEETINGS: Quarterly meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday in January, April, July and

October. The annual membership meeting is the 2nd Tuesday of September.

TRASH DAY: Mondays- The city provides trash and recycle bins. They should be placed at least 4 feet apart at the curb, facing the street.

WATER: Countryside was annexed into the city in 2016. Trash and water are billed together by the city, and water charges are based on usage. Contact the city for any concerns with water, trash or recycling.

MAILBOXES: You can have your mailbox re-keyed at the USPS.

PARK / COMMON AREAS: Residents are welcome to enjoy the park and walking paths throughout the community. Please be kind and pick up after yourself and your pets.

ANNUAL EVENTS: Community Garage Sale and Annual Clean Up each Spring - watch mailbox, newsletter and website for dates.

WILDLIFE: Fun to watch, but feeding the deer and turkeys is strictly prohibited.

STREET PARKING: Per our covenants: *On-street parking is restricted to emergencies, deliveries and guests. No overnight parking on streets is permitted.*


